POSITION SUMMARY

The Chaplain for Episcopal SeniorLife Communities (ESLC) is responsible for the spiritual life at all program sites. They are a management team member and works with staff and volunteers at each program site. The Chaplain oversees and develops a spiritual life team to meet the needs of all residents and staff.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be an Episcopal priest under the pastoral care of the Bishop of Rochester.
- Will be governed by the constitution and canons of the Episcopal Church, the constitution and canons of The Episcopal Diocese of Rochester and the New York State Religious Corporations Act.
- Will function as the chief Chaplain for ESLC.
- Must demonstrate the ability to interact courteously and tactfully with staff, residents, family members, visitor, vendors and the general public.

ESLC DESCRIPTION

Episcopal SeniorLife Communities (ESLC) is a faith-based, nonprofit organization offering a full continuum of compassionate senior care services and senior living communities in Rochester, NY. We support seniors and their families through life's transitions and honor each person's unique desires, beliefs and values—all so that we can fulfill our promise of "Life. Inspired every day."

Founded in 1868 on the Christian values of the Episcopal Church, the Episcopal Church Home has met the needs of our community with care and compassion for more than 150 years. Over the years, we've grown into ESLC, dedicated to understanding and responding to individual and community needs across Rochester. Our communities include affordable housing, independent living apartments and patio homes, assisted living, transitional and rehabilitation care, skilled nursing, specialized memory care and hospice services.

In addition, our Neighborhood and Community Programs provide service coordination and promote health and wellness to seniors in the surrounding areas of our communities, expanding traditional services and allowing seniors to age in their place of choice.

ESLC serves more than 1,400 seniors and their families each year with the assistance of nearly 500 dedicated staff members across nine campuses. A listing of services and communities is included below:

Campuses are located in The City of Rochester (South Wedge and East Avenue), Henrietta, Gates, North Greece, Honeoye Falls, North Greece and Penfield, with Irondequoit in development.
