Resolution Concerning Nominations from the Floor

Proposer: Stand Committee

Resolved, that for the purposes of the Convention to Elect the IX Bishop of Rochester, nominations from the floor (Article VIII, Section 2) shall be accomplished through a petition process prior to the Electing Convention in order to permit adequate background checks for persons so nominated (Article VIII, Section 1a), and be it further

Resolved, that nominations by petition will require a minimum of eight signatories (four Clergy and four lay) from four parishes and two districts in order to meet a standard equivalent to those selected by the Discernment and Nominating Committee, and be it further

Resolved, that nominations by petition will be received by the Standing Committee according to a schedule set by the Standing Committee that will permit all nominated persons to be presented to the Diocese of Rochester at the same time and in the same manner.

Explanation: Article VII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Episcopal Diocese of Rochester requires that accommodation be made for nominations from the floor in the election of a bishop. Best practices for ensuring that all candidates are qualified for election (Article VII, Section 1a) require that time be set aside for thorough background checks. This resolution permits both standards to be met. It further establishes a standard for nomination congruent with the work of the Discernment and Nominating Committee and also ensures that all nominees will be treated equally in being presented to the diocese.
